

ERASMUS+ KA171



Description:

Erasmus+ KA171 projects are coordinated by the University of Alcalá, within the framework of the European Programme Erasmus+ Key Action KA171 of "International Credit Mobility" for undergraduate, master and doctorate students, as well as academic and administrative staff.

Project 2022-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000075900 comprises agreements between the University of Alcalá and **26 partner universities from 18 countries**, which provides mobilities to **120 participants during academic years 2023/24 and 2024/25.**

Project 2023-1- ES01-KA171-HED-000136464 comprises agreements between the University of Alcalá and **4 partner universities from 4 countries**, which provides mobilities to **17 participants during academic years 2024/25 and 2025/26.**

Both projects have been funded with support from the European Commission under the programme Erasmus+, which is the EU Programme in the fields of education, training, youth and sport for the period 2021-2027. Projects under the Action KA171 of Erasmus+ programme promote transnational mobility activities targeting students and academic/administrative staff aiming to:

- Support students in the acquisition of learning outcomes (knowledge, skills and competences) with a view to improving their personal development, their involvement as considerate and active citizens in society and their employability in the European labour market and beyond.
- Support the professional development of those who work in Higher Education.
- Enhance notably the participants' foreign languages competence.
- Raise participants' awareness and understanding of other cultures and countries, offering them the opportunity to build networks of international contacts, to actively participate in society and develop a sense of European citizenship and identity.
- Increase the capacities, attractiveness and international dimension of universities.
- Ensure a better recognition of competences gained through the learning periods abroad.
- Enhance the attractiveness of higher education in Europe.
- Support the internationalization, quality, equity of access and modernization of higher education institutions outside Europe in view of promoting the development of Partner Countries.
- Promote the development and external policy objectives and principles including national ownership, social cohesion, equity, proper geographical balance and diversity.
